PATIENT-FACING AREA	MASKING REQUIREMENT
<ul> <li>Emergency departments</li> <li>UHealth Jackson Urgent Care centers</li> <li>Jackson Behavioral Health Hospital and Jackson South behavioral health inpatient unit</li> <li>Corrections Health Services</li> </ul>	Direct care of patients with symptoms of an acute respiratory infection. Immunocompromised patients, regardless of symptoms.
<ul> <li>Outpatient clinics, such as transplantation (solid organs and bone marrow), cystic fibrosis, dialysis, immunodeficiency, chemotherapy infusion</li> <li>Any procedural units where there is higher risk for respiratory exposure, such as PFT lab and bronchoscopy</li> </ul>	Direct care of patients, regardless of symptoms.
<ul> <li>Inpatient units/areas, including organ transplant, oncology and bone marrow transplant or any other room housing bone marrow transplant patients across Jackson, cystic fibrosis, neonatal ICUs, burn ICUs, dialysis, and immunodeficiency.</li> </ul>	Direct patient care upon entering a room or within 3 feet of distance, regardless of symptoms.

## MASKING IS <u>ALWAYS</u> REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING SCENARIOS:

- In adult and pediatric operating rooms and procedural areas.
- For anyone experiencing symptoms of an acute respiratory infection.
- If requested by patients for individuals providing them with care, in any setting.
- For care of patients on transmission-based isolation precautions, such as airborne, droplet, enhanced droplet, etc.
